Make-up work and policies: It is the responsibility of the student to make up missed work. For an excused absence, you must make up all tests, quizzes and assignments within one week of your return to school or you will receive a grade of zero. For an unexcused absence or a suspension, you must make up all work on the day you return. Make-up work for unexcused absences receives a maximum of 69% of the total grade earned. If a student is at school on the day of a quiz, test or homework check and misses Latin class for some reason, s/he is required to take the test/quiz or turn in the homework assignment on the day s/he returns. The teacher reserves the right to make any student who is absent the day of quiz, test or homework check take the test/quiz or turn in the assignment upon his/her return. Tests and quizzes are posted ahead of time on the website and in the monthly calendar. Homework assignments are also posted daily on the website. This policy also pertains to any material which must be printed for class off of the website.

NET Classroom posting dates: Teachers are required to have grades updated and posted online in 2008 on Sept. 5, Sept. 19, Oct. 10, Oct. 24, Dec. 5, January 23 (2009), February 6, February 27, March 13, March 27, April 17, May 11 (SENIORS ONLY) and May 26. Teachers are not expected to have grades updated and posted online at any other time. Access to NET Classroom will not be available to parents or students from December 15, 2008 until January 6, 2009 in order to allow teachers to finish entering in fall semester grades and final exams.
